TENTATIVE RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY BYPASS OF DISINFECTED SECONDARY EFFLUENT TO HYPERION'S 1-MILE OUTFALL DURING THE EFFLUENT PUMPING PLANT HEADER REPLACEMENT PROJECT - EDWARD C. LITTLE WATER RECYCLING FACILITY (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0063401, CI-7449)

Enclosed please find a copy of the Tentative Resolution approving the temporary bypass of the brine effluent from the E.C. Little Water Recycling Facility to the Hyperion 1-mile outfall during the Effluent Pumping Plant Header Replacement Project that is tentatively scheduled from September 21, 2015, to November 02, 2015.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on **September 10, 2015, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the **Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California**, will consider the enclosed tentative Resolution and comments submitted in writing regarding any and all portions thereof. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff. The agenda for the meeting will be posted on the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board's website (http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/board_info/agenda/index.shtml) approximately one week prior to the meeting.

Written comments regarding this tentative Resolution must be received at the Regional Water Board's office by **5:00 p.m. on August 21, 2015**, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date will not be considered, absent extraordinary circumstances. Timely submittal of written comments is required to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.
