**NOTICE OF LODGING OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION TO
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT UNDER THE CLEAN WATER ACT**

**WRITTEN COMMENTS DUE BY
5:00 P.M., August 26, 2013**

Notice is hereby given that on July 23, 2013, a proposed Third Modification to the Settlement Agreement and Final Order ("Third Modification") in United States and State of California ex rel. California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region v. City of Los Angeles, Civil Action No. 01-191-RSWL, was lodged with the United States District Court for the Central District of California, Western Division. The United States and the State's action is consolidated with Santa Monica Baykeeper v. The City of Los Angeles, Civil Action No. 98-9039-RSWL.

The Proposed Third Modification adds several potential Supplemental Environmental Projects ("SEPs") for the City of Los Angeles to implement in order to meet the Settlement Agreement's requirement to spend \$8.5 million on SEPs.

You may submit written comments on the Third Modification, which must be received by 5:00 p.m. on August 26, 2013. Comments must be addressed to the Assistant Attorney General, U.S. DOJ - Environment and Natural Resources Division, and either emailed to pubcomment-ees.enrd@usdoj.gov or mailed to P.O. Ref. No. 90-5-1-1-809/1. After the public comment period closes, the U.S. Department of Justice will transmit copies of comments received to the Los Angeles Regional Board for consideration.
