SUBJECT: NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION TO THE PALOS VERDES PENINSULA ENHANCED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (NPDES PERMIT NO. CAS004001; ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175 AS AMENDED BY STATE WATER BOARD ORDER WQ 2015-0075 AND LOS ANGELES WATER BOARD ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175-A01)

The Palos Verdes Peninsula Watershed Management Group¹ (Peninsula Group or Permittees) implements the Palos Verdes Peninsula Enhanced Watershed Management Program (PVP EWMP) under Part VI.C of the Los Angeles County MS4 Permit (Order No. R4-2012-0175).

On December 13, 2018, the Peninsula Group, requested as part of its 2017-2018 Annual Report and Adaptive Management Process, a modification to the PVP EWMP. The Permittees would like to customize the Public Information and Participation Program and implement enhancements to sediment control best management practices at small and large construction sites.
