TENTATIVE ORDER
AMENDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. R5-2002-0138
FOR
TEICHERT AGGREGATES
HALLWOOD FACILITY
YUBA COUNTY**

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

On 19 July 2002, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, (Central Valley Water Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R5-2002-0138 for the Teichert Aggregates (Discharger) Hallwood Facility in Yuba County. The WDRs prescribe discharge requirements for the operation of the facility located at 3311 Walnut Avenue in Marysville. At this location the Discharger extracts and processes aggregate and manufactures and recycles asphalt concrete.

The Central Valley Water Board will consider adoption of an amendment to WDRs Order No. R5-2002-0138. The Amending Order proposes to allow the Discharger to relocate its settling pond anywhere on the facility but limits the pond to a maximum size of 15-acres. The Discharger completed a focused Environmental Impact Report for the California State Mining and Geology Board. Therefore, the Amending Order additionally proposes to require the Discharger to complete studies and submit technical reports to satisfy the identified mitigation measure.
