TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is the tentative Order to amend Time Schedule Order R5-2015-0034 for the Placer County Department of Facility Services (Discharger) Sewer Maintenance District No. 1 Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility). Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order should be submitted to this office no later than 5:00 p.m. on **2 December 2015** in order for us to give them full consideration prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board). Written material submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **2 December 2015** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the proposed Order to amend Time Schedule Order R5-2015-0034 at its **10/11 December 2015** Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are enclosed. Regulations require that the Discharger post by **2 November 2015** one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The nearest city hall or county courthouse,
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and
- The public entrance of the Facility.

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **16 November 2015**.
