### NOTICE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS GENERAL ORDERS FOR OIL FIELD DISCHARGES TO LAND

#### TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

The Central Valley Water Board will consider at its 18/19 August 2016 meeting three separate tentative Waste Discharge Requirements General Orders (General Orders) for discharges of oil field produced wastewater to land within the Tulare Lake Basin. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the General Orders at its 18/19 August 2016 meeting.
