SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY AND DELTA WATER QUALITY COALITION – 2013-2015 MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR HIGH PRIORITY SITE SUBWATERSHEDS SCHEDULE REVISION

Thank you for submitting the 23 January 2012 San Joaquin County and Delta Water Quality Coalition (Coalition) Management Plan schedule modification request. A change in the Coalition's schedule for addressing each high priority site subwatershed with a detailed, focused management plan is requested for two reasons: (1) Roberts Island at Whiskey Slough Pump replaced two management plan monitoring sites (approved 12 January 2012), affecting the current High Priority monitoring schedule, and (2) Bear Creek at North Alpine Road will be added to the High Priority schedule because the site experienced three chlorpyrifos and three malathion exceedances in 2011. Table 1 exhibits the former and revised High Priority monitoring schedule.
