ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF STOCKTON ALEXANDRIA AND FIVE MILE SLOUGH CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WDID#5B39CR00367A1), SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

This Order responds to the 14 September 2022 request for an amendment of the Alexandria and Five Mile Slough Culvert Replacement Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B39CR00367). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 21 March 2022. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The City of Stockton is requesting an amendment for an 0.03 acre increase in temporary impacts to stream channel habitat from the installation of a new cofferdam within Five Mile Slough. The location of the new cofferdam is shown the updated Project Impacts Map (Figure 2).

The Certification is amended as shown below:

Description of Direct Impacts to Waters of the State

Project fill/excavation quantities for all impacts are summarized in Tables 1 and 2. Permanent impacts are categorized as those resulting in a physical loss in area and also those degrading ecological condition.
