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RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY; CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; CAMINO SAFETY PROJECT (EA 03-4E62U); EL DORADO COUNTY

On 12 October 2021, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality (General Order; 2003-0003-DWQ) to the California Department of Transportation for pipe flushing in the Camino Safety Project (Caltrans Project EA 03-4E62U). The Discharger was assigned enrollee number 2003-0003-DWQ-0221.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination dated 5 April 2024 stating that discharges to land have ceased. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0221 is hereby rescinded.
