RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2012-0010-DWQ AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVERY (ASR) PILOT TEST, CITY OF WOODLAND, YOLO COUNTY

On 3 January 2014, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability (NOA) granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *General Waste Discharge Requirements for ASR Projects that Inject Drinking Water into Groundwater*, Order 2012-0010-DWQ (General Order) to the City of Woodland (City). The NOA was for the pilot test to evaluate the viability of an aquifer storage and recovery program for the City. City Well 28 was used as an injection well. Groundwater elevation and water quality data was obtained from two nearby monitoring wells (MW-3 and MW-4). The City was issued Order 2012-0010-DWQ-RB5S-0003 for implementation of the ASR pilot test.

Your Notice of Termination to rescind the Notice of Applicability under the General Order submitted on 6 February 2015 states that pilot test is complete and all injection and extraction activities have ceased. The injection of drinking water into City Well 28 was completed on 2 March 2014. The extraction of injected drinking water was completed on 17 March 2014. Based on this information, coverage under the General Order is hereby rescinded.
