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CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP; COMFORT INN AND SUITES SEQUOIA KINGS CANYON ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM; NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY 2014-0153-DWQ-R5314; TULARE COUNTY

On 19 October 2022, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board received a signed Form 200 for a change of ownership for the Comfort Inn and Suites Sequoia Kings Canyon Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (Facility). The Facility was enrolled under State Water Resources Control Board's Order 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order) on 28 August 2019 by Notice of Applicability (NOA) 2014-0153-DWQ-R5314. The NOA was revised on 25 November 2019. The NOA lists BSK Investment, LLC as the Facility owner and Discharger. The October 2022 Form 200 lists the new Facility owner as SUK Inc and the owner of the land as JUM LLC.

This letter recognizes SUK Inc. and JUM LLC, collectively, as the new Discharger for the NOA and responsible for complying with the General Order, NOA 2014-0153-DWQ-R5314 (including Monitoring and Reporting Program [MRP] 2014-0153-DWQ-R5314). Please note that as the Discharger, you are required to submit self-monitoring reports specified in MRP 2014-0153-DWQ-R5314 and pay future annual fees. Salt Control Program

On 5 January 2021, the Central Valley Water Board issued BSK Investment, LLC a Notice to Comply under the Salt Control Program (**CV-SALTS ID: 3015**) for the Facility. The Notice to Comply required permittees to submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) for the Salt Control Program to the Central Valley Water Board by 15 July 2021. An NOI for the Salt

Control Program was submitted for the Facility on 22 June 2021, selecting Pathway 2 – Alternative Salinity Permitting Approach. The Alternative Salinity Permitting Approach requires permittees to participate in and provide minimal financial support to the Prioritization and Optimization (P&O) Study. The 2021 P&O fee for the Facility were paid on 5 June 2021; however, the 2022 P&O fee for the Facility is past due. In addition to the P&O fees, each person for whom waste discharge requirements have been prescribed pursuant to Section 13263 of the Water Code shall submit, to the State Water Resources Control Board, the required annual fee. According to our records, the 2021/2022 fiscal year fee was paid on 20 January 2022. The 2022/2023 fiscal year annual fee should be issued within the next couple of months.

If you desire to make any changes to the wastewater treatment system (and/or quality/location of discharge) or increase the design flow for the wastewater treatment system, you must submit a new Report of Waste Discharge.
