SUBJECT: NOTICE OF TERMINATION FOR GENERAL ORDER NO. R5-2008-0149-050 AND MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM (MRP) No. R5-2014-0824, HIRA PETROLEUM, 1573 NORTH BEALE ROAD, MARYSVILLE, YUBA COUNTY, LUSTIS No. 580236

On 30 May 2014, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued A Notice of Applicability under Order No. R5-2008-0149, *General Order for In-Situ Groundwater Remediation At Sites With Volatile Organic Compounds, Nitrogen Compounds, Perchlorate, Pesticides, Semi-Volatile Compounds, Hexavalent Chromium and/or Petroleum Hydrocarbons*. In the Notice of Applicability, the project was assigned site-specific Order No. R5-2008-0149-050 and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) R5-2014-0824.

Hira Petroleum conducted remediation for this project on 23 and 24 June 2014, which included the application of in-situ chemical oxidants to the site's subsurface. The short-term remediation project is no longer needed to mitigate groundwater contaminants from the former underground tank release.

On 31 December 2014, you requested termination of coverage for the project. Therefore, with an effective date of 31 December 2014 General Order No. R5-2008-0149-050 and MRP R5-2014-0824 are hereby terminated. Invoicing for General Order coverage will be modified accordingly.
