On 19 March 2009, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, issued a Notice of Applicability for coverage under the Petroleum Cleanup General Order to Kinder Morgan Energy Partners, L.P. and Santa Fe Pacific Pipeline, L.P. (Discharger), for the Santa Fe Pacific Pipeline, L.P., Exit 174 Pipeline Release Project (SFPP). The groundwater cleanup and disposal project was completed on 30 July 2010.

Our office received a letter on 6 October 2010 from the Discharger, stating that the groundwater treatment and disposal system unit has been decommissioned during the period from the 24th through 29 September 2010 and no discharge has occurred after this date. Therefore, through this letter, our office is confirming that coverage under Petroleum Cleanup General Order No. R5-2008-0085-007 is no longer necessary and was terminated, effective 6 October 2010. Invoicing for General Order coverage will be modified accordingly.
