NOTICE OF TERMINATION; LIMITED THREAT GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2016-0076-01, PHILLIPS 66 COMPANY, GROUNDWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM ADJACENT TO THE CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, MERCED COUNTY

Thank you for submitting the Notice of Termination Form on 28 June 2018 (dated 27 June 2018) requesting termination of coverage under the Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076-01 for the Phillips 66 Company, Groundwater Treatment Project (Project) adjacent to the California Aqueduct.

On 20 April 2018, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability for the Project, which was assigned Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076-01-037 and WDID No. 5C242032001. Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage is hereby terminated as of 29 June 2018 through this letter.

Please note that you must still submit your second quarter monitoring report required under the Limited Threat General Order by 1 August 2018. Failure to do so subjects you to mandatory minimum penalties or discretionary penalties.
