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NOTICE OF TERMINATION; LIMITED THREAT GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2016-0076-01, SACRAMENTO DEEP WATER SHIP CHANNEL NITROGEN ENRICHMENT STUDY PROJECT, YOLO COUNTY

Thank you for submitting the Notice of Termination Form dated 2 February 2021 requesting termination of coverage under the Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076-01 for the Sacramento Deep Water Ship Channel Nitrogen Enrichment Study Project (Project).

On 22 May 2018, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability for the Project, which was assigned Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076-036 and Waste Discharger Identification 5A34NP00096. Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage is hereby terminated as of 2 February 2021 through this letter.

Please note that you must still submit your last quarterly monitoring report required under the Limited Threat General Order to the Compliance/Enforcement staff. Failure to do so subjects you to mandatory minimum penalties or discretionary penalties.
