Adoption of New Waste Discharge Requirements
for

**GUENOC WINERY CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENT
LANGTRY FARMS, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY
AND MAGOON ESTATES LIMITED
LAKE COUNTY**

Langtry Farms, Limited Liability Company (facility owner) and Magoon Estates Limited (landowner) propose to construct and operate a bioreactor wastewater treatment system and Class II surface impoundment at the Guenoc Winery. Five unlined ponds are currently used to treat and dispose of liquid designated waste. Pursuant to Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, such waste can only be discharged to a Class I or a Class II surface impoundment equipped with engineered lining and a leachate collection and recovery system. The Discharger has proposed to upgrade the existing ponds to a single Class II surface impoundment to comply with Title 27.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **20 February 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were issued 19 January 2007. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **20 February 2007**.
