TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0079367) renewal and Cease and Desist Order (CDO) for the Placer County Department of Facility Services (Discharger), Placer County Sewer Maintenance District No. 3 Wastewater Treatment Plant. Continuation of the Regional Water Quality Control Board Public Hearing for adoption of these tentative documents is scheduled for 21/22 June 2007. The Continued Hearing will be limited in scope to information pertaining to the "underline/strike-out" text in the enclosed tentative documents that denotes late revisions regarding the following issues:

- Addition of a Compliance Schedule for Proposed Turbidity Effluent Limits,
- Addition of Compliance Determination Language for Regulated Flow,
- Addition of Organochlorine Pesticide Effluent Limits and corresponding Compliance Schedule, and
- Correction of technical errors in the calculation of the proposed Ammonia and Mercury Effluent Limitations.

Public comments must be limited to the scope of the issues listed above and submitted to the Regional Water Quality Control Board office by **8 June 2007** to be given full consideration prior to the June 2007 Regional Water Board meeting. Comments submitted after 8 June 2007 or outside of the scope of the information denoted in "underline/strike-out" text and the issues listed above may not be considered.
