ORDER NO. R5-2007-

RESCINDING NPDES PERMIT

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Order, which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2002-0162 (NPDES No. CA0079979) (NPDES Permit) adopted 6 September 2001, authorized discharges of wastewater from the Wetsel-Oviatt Lumber Company in El Dorado County. However, the mill has closed, and equipment, buildings and two waste treatment ponds have been eliminated. The NPDES Permit has expired, and is no longer necessary. Rescinding the NPDES Permit does not absolve the Discharger from the liability for mandatory penalties incurred during the effective term of the permit.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above NPDES Permit is rescinded.
