**CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
(NPDES NO. CAXXXXX)**

for

**CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AND CAIN-PAPAI TRUST
FOREST MEADOWS WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY
CALAVERAS COUNTY**

Calaveras County Water District and Cain-Papais Trust (Dischargers) applied for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit authorization to discharge tertiary treated reclaimed wastewater from the Forest Meadows Wastewater Reclamation Facility to the Stanislaus River. The proposed NPDES permit allows a seasonal discharge up to 0.84 million gallons per day of tertiary treated effluent into Collierville Tunnel that empties into the Stanislaus River, a water of the United States. The proposed discharge would occur during wet winters from 1 December through 15 April, when wastewater flows exceed the Facility's effluent storage capacity.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **18 January 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than by noon on **5 December 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **5 December 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
