SUBJECT: Pacific Forest and Watershed Lands Stewardship Council

BOARD ACTION: *Report on Council Activities By Board Representative Soapy Mulholland*

BACKGROUND: The Stewardship Council was established in 2004 as part of a PG&E settlement agreement with the California Public Utilities Commission. The agreement establishes that 140,000 acres of PG&E's watershed lands will be conserved for its public and environmental resources. Membership on the Council governing board was established in the settlement agreement, and includes a representative from the Central Valley Water Board.

Soapy Mulholland served as the Board's representative while she was a Central Valley Water Board member, and was appointed by the Board at the January 2010 meeting to continue to serve as the Board's representative. Dan Odenweller is the Board's alternate representative to the Council.

Ms. Mulholland will provide a report on Council activities.
