Subject: Water treatment

Two billion dollars is a huge price tag to upgrade the Sacramento wastewater treatment facility, especially when it may not help in improving the delta, as intended. There are many variables affecting the delta region, and probably many different solutions to try. I suggest you start with projects that are more efficient.

We currently pay \$79.45 every two months for our sewer service, half to Sacramento Area Sewer District and half to Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District. That is beside the \$1.99 we pay in utility tax and \$58.78 we pay for stormwater charges and solid waste service. These are not optional costs, like having telephone or cable. As homeowners we are compelled to pay them. Our charges have risen in each of the previous two billing cycles and will most likely continue to rise quickly as they have in the past few years. Adding more cost to these bills that are already hard to swallow will simply choke Sacramento.
