Subject: Proposed Wastewater Discharge Permit

Members of the Board,

My husband and I, both retired, own and manage rental properties in the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (District) service region. This email is in opposition to the proposed discharge permit proposal that will be considered by your Board in early December.

Businesses across the state are struggling in this economy. Few regions have suffered the way Sacramento has in this downturn. A \$2 billion bill to business and customers is simply unreasonable at this time.

Like other businesses, the state of our industry is at best unhealthy. We are currently experiencing declining rents, higher vacancies, and increasing utility bills. It is unimaginable how we would absorb a whopping \$30-\$40 per month increase!

Given the strong disagreements by experts on this issue, we are not convinced that there is sufficient scientific evidence to justify this proposal.

I ask that you vote against this proposed rate increase when it comes before you.
