NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR
UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY
ROSEVILLE YARD
CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENT
PLACER COUNTY

Union Pacific Railroad Company (Discharger) submitted a Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD) for revision of waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the industrial wastewater ponds at the Roseville Yard in Roseville. The ROWD was submitted pursuant to a Central Valley Water Board staff request for a ROWD meeting the requirements of Title 27, California Code of Regulations (Title 27). The Discharger discharges industrial waste water and storm water runoff generated from approximately 12 acres of the Roseville Yard where various activities are conducted including locomotive and equipment maintenance. Industrial wastewater and storm water from these areas is routed to a pretreatment facility prior to discharge to the sanitary sewer. The pretreatment facility includes a lined surface impoundment for storage of excess wastewater and storm water runoff. Sampling data indicate that the water in the impoundment is a designated waste that must be regulated under Title 27. Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later **19 December 2011**. The request must

explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than by noon on **19 December 2011**. Written materials submitted after noon on [date] will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
