Hello all,

I was out of the office this morning, but here is the notice for the Wildhurst Winery Discharge Permit. The notice has a webpage where you can find the attachments with permit conditions.

The comments are due tomorrow. I am concerned that the permit allows the treated wastewater to be applied by drip, spray, or flood irrigation to a pear orchard adjacent to Kelsey Creek. I am commenting that the flood option should be dropped from allowed application due to the proximity to the creek.
