- Item 14** **POM Wonderful, LLC, Whole Fruit and Juice Extraction Plant, Fresno County** – Consideration of Waste Discharge Requirements and Resolution approving a Negative Declaration.

Finding 54

Page 12. Edit Finding 54 of the Waste Discharge Requirements as follows.

54. Based on the threat and complexity of the discharge, the plant is determined to be classified as **2AB** as defined below:
- a. Category 2 threat to water quality: “Those discharges of waste that could impair the designated beneficial uses of the receiving water, cause short-term violations of water quality objectives, cause secondary drinking water standards to be violated, or cause a nuisance.”
 - b. ~~Category A complexity, defined as: “Any discharge of toxic wastes; any small volume discharge containing toxic waste; any facility having numerous discharge points and groundwater monitoring; or any Class 1 waste management unit.”~~
 - b. *Category B complexity, defined as: “Any discharger not included in Category A that has physical, chemical, or biological treatment systems (except for septic systems with subsurface disposal), or any Class 2 or Class 3 waste management units.”***
