**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. R5-2010-0064  
FOR**

**CITY OF MT. SHASTA AND  
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE  
CITY OF MT.SHASTA WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
SISKIYOU COUNTY**

The City of Mt. Shasta (Discharger) owns and operates the City of Mt. Shasta Wastewater Treatment Plant, a publically owned treatment works located at 2500 Grant Road, Mt. Shasta, Siskiyou County. The Discharger may be contacted by mail at 305 North Mt. Shasta Blvd., Mt. Shasta, CA 96067. Effluent from the wastewater treatment plant is discharged to the Sacramento River, a water of the United States, Mt. Shasta Resort Golf Course, or to a leachfield adjacent to Highway 89 on land owned by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service.

On 27 May 2010, Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) found the Discharger had completed required tasks as specified in Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order R5-2007-0056 and Cease and Desist Order (CDO) R5-2007-0057 to pursuit compliance with final effluent limits for ammonia, copper, and zinc. Regional Board rescinded CDO R5-2007-0057 and adopted CDO R5-2010-0064 to provide the Discharger interim effluent limits and a single time schedule to fully implement additional control measures specified in plans submitted by the Discharger, or take other actions to come into compliance with final effluent limits. This CDO R5-2010-0064 set a final compliance deadline of 1 June 2012 to meet final effluent limits for ammonia, copper, and zinc.

The Discharger has achieved compliance by completing all of the tasks in CDO R5-2010-0064 or by taking other actions to come into compliance with final effluent limits and is making diligent progress towards meeting those requirements as specified in TSO R5-2012-0087. Compliance with Cease and Desist Order R5-2010-0064 is no longer needed.

The Regional Board will consider rescinding Cease and Desist Order R5-2010-0064. A public hearing to address this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of the Regional Board
- City of Redding

Designated parties but not interested persons will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. Regional Board staff will prepare the administrative record, and may present evidence, make an oral presentation and cross-examine opposing witnesses.

Interested persons may not cross examine witnesses, and will not be subject to cross examination. Interested persons may submit evidence (e.g., photographs, eye-witness testimony, monitoring data) if the evidence is submitted in accordance with the deadlines for submitting evidence described below. Interested persons who present evidence may be subject to cross-examination. Interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5:00 pm on 30 August 2013**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is affected by the discharge.

The notification for the Planned Rescission of Cease and Desist Order No. R5-2010-064 was issued on **31 July 2013**. Persons wishing to comment on this item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 30 August 2013**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Regional Board Chair. Both designated parties and interested persons may be asked to respond to clarifying questions from Regional Board members, counsel staff or others, at the discretion of the Regional Board.
