### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

For Consideration of Resolutions approving  
A Management Agency Agreement with the  
U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and  
A Real Time Management Program Framework Document  
For the Control of Salt and Boron Discharges to the  
Lower San Joaquin River

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider resolutions to approve revisions to an existing Management Agency Agreement (MAA) with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) and to approve a Real Time Salinity Management (RTMP) framework document for the Lower San Joaquin River during the 4/5 December 2014 Central Valley Water Board meeting. Two letters commenting on the draft MAA and the draft RTMP were received, responses to comments have been prepared, and both documents have been revised to reflect comments and responses. The revised MAA was received on 31 October 2014, and the revised RTMP framework document was received on 17 October 2014.

On 31 October 2014, the USBR submitted a draft of the first Annual Work Plan which the USBR agreed to provide in the revised MAA. The Central Valley Water Board will not be considering approval of the work plan at the December 2014 meeting. However, the work plan is available for public review. Announcement of a public review and comment period for the work plan is being issued in a separate notice.
