The following summarizes the proposed late revisions to the Donner Summit Public Utility District Wastewater Treatment Plant's NPDES Permit renewal.

1. **Best Management Practices and Pollution Prevention – Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan, Special Provision C.3.a**

Clarify the requirements of the Salinity Evaluation and Minimization plan as shown below in underline/strikeout format.

**Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan.** The Discharger shall ~~update and~~ continue to implement a salinity evaluation and minimization plan to ~~identify and~~ address sources of salinity from the Facility. ~~The updated plan shall be submitted to the Central Valley Water Board within 9 months of the effective date of this Order.~~ The Discharger shall provide annual reports discussing the effectiveness of implementing the salinity evaluation and minimization plan, and changes in the salinity in the effluent discharge if it is increasing. The salinity evaluation and minimization plan shall be reviewed and updated as necessary as part of the report of waste discharge. If the plan is updated, it shall be submitted with the report of waste discharge, 180 days prior to the Order expiration date. ~~demonstrating reasonable progress in the reduction of salinity in its discharge to the South Yuba River.~~ The annual reports shall be submitted in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program (Attachment E, section X.D.1).
