**SUBJECT:**

REVIEW OF DIAZINON AND CHLORPYRIFOS CONTROL PROGRAMS

**BOARD ACTION:**

**BACKGROUND:**

Board staff will provide a brief overview and update on Control Programs for the pesticides, diazinon and chlorpyrifos. Diazinon and chlorpyrifos have been a water quality concern for over 20 years because of the potential impacts to aquatic life. To address widespread impairments in surface waters, the Central Valley Water Board amended the Water Quality Control Plan for the Sacramento and San Joaquin River Basins in 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2014 to establish Control Programs, numeric water quality objectives (WQOs), and Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for these pesticides. Starting in 2003, the Central Valley Water Board's Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (ILRP) implemented requirements to reduce discharges of these pesticides. This Informational Item serves to provide the Board an update on the effectiveness of the Control Programs.
