AVAILABILITY OF REGIONAL BOARD RESPONSE TO PETITIONS REGARDING FAILURE TO ISSUE NPDES PERMIT TO CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME (CDFG), FOR USE OF ROTENONE IN SILVER KING CREEK PAIUTE CUTTHROAT TROUT RESTORATION PROJECT -- ALPINE COUNTY

This letter is being provided to Interested Parties in the above-referenced matter. At a September 8, 2004 Public Hearing the Regional Board considered, but did not adopt, a proposed NPDES permit for CDFG's proposed use of the poison rotenone to restore the threatened Paiute Cutthroat Trout at Silver King Creek, Alpine County. Rotenone is used to eliminate non-native fish that can outcompete and interbreed with Paiute Cutthroat Trout.

Any person who is aggrieved by an action, or a failure to act, by a Regional Water Quality Control Board may file a petition for review with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), subject to statutory and regulatory provisions (California Water Code Section 13320; Title 23, California Code of Regulations (CCR) sections 2050-2068). The Regional Board's failure to issue an NPDES permit to the Department of Fish and Game has been petitioned by Trout Unlimited (State Water Board File No. A-1669) and jointly by the CDFG and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (File No. A-1669(a)).
