**IN RE: COMMENTS REQUESTED BY APRIL 23, 2012 – CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENT OF ORDER NO. R6V-2011-0005A1, ISSUED TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E)**

**Dear Mr. Singer:**

**The People of Hinkley, California [those People that are not an Ex Parte to prior, precedent setting lawsuits], effective immediately, are no longer interseted to provide any comments to this Board, on the simple ground, that all administrative remedy are now deemed as exhausted.**

**Anything this Board elects to do, will not be binding upon the People of Hinkley, California, absent of due process of law [those People of Hinkley are as referenced herein above]. (Emphasis added)**

**There is nothing further more to comment, deliberate, stipulate and settle, until the Poluter Discharger Pacific Gas and Electric Company / PG&E Corp., a Parent compmany, clean-up to the level prior to poisoning – contaminating this town ground waters, soils and air with Cr6+, to wit:**

- (i) In Ground Waters, so-called Background Level of Cr6+ plume, of any parts per billion amount, is set-aside, until is determined by invoking the due process of law, Lis Pendens.**
- (ii) Due to the current enforcement for inhaling Cr6+ particulate in air, which enforcement limit is set at 5 µg/m<sup>3</sup>, and every time there is dust storm, (very frequent in Hinkley, CA) from the may, over 40, alfalfa [dry] fields throughout Hinkley, CA, from the poisoned soils (irrigate with up to 4,100 ppb of Cr6+ plume), and the air in within the entire town of Hinkley being severely contaminated, which caused numerous skin and lung cancers, this Board must refrain from any decision, or rule making, since is out of jurisdiction.**
- (iii) This Board has no authority in oversight for contaminated – poisoned soils and air.**

**THEREFORE, until the many issues mentioned herein are resolved, by invoking the due process of law clause, this Board should refrain in imposing anything upon the People of Hinkley, California.**
