Project Description: The Department of Parks and Recreation proposes to restore the degraded lower portion of Round Valley Meadow, in Mount San Jacinto State Park, by borrowing nearby (on-site) native soil material to fill a gully created by past disturbance of the seasonal unnamed stream draining into the meadow. The stream will be restored to a stable, natural course at its natural meadow surface elevation. Borrowed material will come from two nearby upland and depositional sites.
