Project Description:

The project proposes dredging at the North Shore Beach and Yacht Club (NSBYC) marina of the Salton Sea to allow boats to once again use the boat ramp to access the waterbody. In recent years, the inlet to the NSBYC marina has suffered from accumulation of sediment from wind driven wave action and littoral drift prohibiting boat access to the Salton Sea. In addition, the water surface elevation of the Salton Sea has declined approximately 10 feet from -228 feet mean sea level (msl) from 2004 to 2020 (USGS 2020). To render the marina usable, the County proposed to dredge the marina to a depth of -224 feet msl.
