AB 1079 requires the state to develop a **Strategic Plan** to clean up the New River. A Technical Advisory Committee was established to assist the state in developing the plan.

The committee has made substantial progress on the plan and will be hosting a series of meetings in the Imperial Valley to present and receive feedback on alternatives to clean up the river. We hope you can join members of the committee at one of the three public meetings this November.

The events include light refreshments. There will be English and Spanish speakers available to discuss the project and alternatives.

## What is the New River Improvement Project?

Assembly Bill 1079 (Pub. Resources Code, § 71103.5, added by Stats. 2009, ch. 382, § 1), authored by Assemblyman Victor M. Perez, requires the California-Mexico Border Relations Council to create a **Strategic Plan** to study, monitor, remediate and enhance the New River's water quality to protect human health, and develop a river parkway suitable for public use and enjoyment. The Council established a Technical Advisory Committee to assist with development of the plan.
