Dear Mr. Pack:

Enclosed is a copy of Mandatory Penalties Complaint (MPC) No. R8-2004-0100. The complaint is in response to violations of effluent limitations specified in waste discharge requirements, Order No. 99-5. It was issued pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385 (h) and (i) and proposes the assessment of a penalty of \$12,000 for four violations that occurred between January 2004 and February 2004.

Should you wish to waive your right to a public hearing on this matter, please sign the enclosed waiver form and submit it, along with the bottom portion of the attached invoice and a check or money order for the amount of \$12,000, by December 2, 2004, to the address on the invoice. 

YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE THAT:

1. Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Regional Board), must impose mandatory penalties pursuant to California Water Code (Water Code) Section 13385.
2. A hearing concerning this complaint will be held before the Regional Board within 90 days of the date of issuance of this complaint, unless EMWD waives its right to a hearing. Waiver procedures are specified on Page 2 of this complaint. If the hearing in this matter is not waived, the hearing will be held during the Regional Board's regular meeting on December 20, 2004 at the City of Loma Linda Council Chambers, 25541 Barton Road, Loma Linda, California. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. EMWD or its representatives will have an opportunity to appear and be heard and to contest the allegations in this complaint and the imposition of mandatory penalties by the Regional Board.
3. This complaint is based on the following facts:
 - a. On June 25, 1999, the Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements, Order No. 99-5 (NPDES No. CA8000188), for EMWD. On July 1, 2003, the Regional Board adopted Order No. R8-2003-0066, amending Order No. 99-5. These requirements regulate discharges of tertiary treated wastewater from EMWD's regional water reclamation facilities to Temescal Creek.
 - b. EMWD submitted self-monitoring reports (January 2004 – April 2004) for their discharge to Temescal Creek, which show effluent limit violations of selenium and cyanide. These violations are summarized on Attachment "A," which is Page 3 of this complaint.
4. Water Code Section 13385 (h) requires the Regional Board to assess a mandatory minimum penalty of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for each serious violation.

5. As shown in Attachment "A", EMWD incurred a total of five violations between January 2004 and February 2004. For the six-month period covered by Complaint No. R8-2004-0100, one non-serious violation that occurred during January 2004 is not subject to a mandatory penalty assessment in accordance with Water Code Section 13385(i). The remaining violations are considered serious as defined under Water Code Section 13385 (h) (2).
6. Four violations out of the total of five violations are subject to mandatory minimum penalties of \$3,000 for each violation. In accordance with Water Code Section 13385(h), the mandatory minimum penalties for the five effluent limit violations cited in Attachment "A" are \$12,000.
7. In accordance with Water Code Section 13385(c), the Regional Board may impose administrative civil liability for the five violations cited in Attachment "A". The maximum administrative civil liability that may be imposed for these violations is \$50,000.
8. The Executive Officer proposes that mandatory penalties of \$12,000 be imposed on EMWD by the Regional Board for the violations cited above.
9. You may waive your right to a hearing. If you waive your right to a hearing, please sign the attached waiver, which is Page 4 of this complaint, and return it together with a check payable to the State Water Resources Control Board in the amount of the mandatory penalties proposed in paragraph 8, above. An invoice for this amount is enclosed.

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region, must impose Mandatory Minimum Penalties, pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385. EMWD is alleged to have violated selenium and cyanide limits contained in its waste discharge requirements, Order No. 99-5, in January and February, 2004.

On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, Complaint No. R8-2004-0100 for mandatory minimum penalty was issued to EMWD by the Executive Officer of the Regional Board on November 16, 2004. The complaint proposes a mandatory minimum penalty of \$12,000.

The complaint and related documents may be inspected and copied at the Regional Board office at 3737 Main Street, Suite 500, Riverside, California, by appointment between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. Appointments may be scheduled by calling the Regional Board office at (909) 782-4130.

Interested persons are invited to submit written comments on this matter. Comments must be submitted by December 10, 2004.

For the accuracy of the record, all testimony (oral statements) should also be submitted in writing.
