Brief Description of Project:

Project Description: To inform the design of the spillway structure, the proposed geotechnical investigations are needed to provide necessary geologic and geotechnical information to fully characterize the existing soil and subsurface conditions at the site of the new spillway structure.

Project Activities: The geotechnical investigations would support the Santiago Creek Dam Outlet Tower and Spillway Improvements Project. The areas temporarily impacted for geotechnical investigations would be permanently or temporarily impacted by the Project. Impacts to these areas will be mitigated as described in the Environmental Impacts Report (in Preparation). Projects considered in the Cumulative Impact Analysis are the Santiago Canyon Road Safety Improvement Project (minimal biological impacts would occur along the existing roadway), and the City of Orange and County of Orange Housing Elements (no impact on biological resources). When considered with the cumulative list of projects, the Project would not have a disproportionate contribution to cumulative impacts. Each project would be mitigated at the project-level and cumulative impacts would be less than significant.
