NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING (Date of Notice: November 1, 2005)

Administrative Settlement Agreement (Resolution No. R8-2005-0120)
And
Remedial Investigation Order by Consent No. R8-2005-0121

For

GOODRICH CORPORATION

A hearing before the Regional Board will be held on November 16, 2005. The Board will consider adoption of (1) a Resolution authorizing the Executive Officer to enter into an Administrative Settlement Agreement with Goodrich Corporation; and (2) a Remedial Investigation Order by Consent. An agenda announcement has been prepared and made available to the public.

BACKGROUND

A draft Administrative Settlement Agreement and a Remedial Investigation Order by Consent and a Work Plan have been prepared to address certain activities to be undertaken by Goodrich Corporation regarding the perchlorate and trichloroethylene contamination in the vicinity of an area generally referred to as the "160 acres" located in Rialto. The draft documents have been circulated to interested parties and are available to the public for viewing on the Regional Board's website.

THE HEARING

At the hearing, the Board will receive a staff presentation regarding the draft documents and comments from Goodrich Corporation representatives. Members of the public are invited to comment on the draft documents. The Board has allocated a three-hour block of time for this matter. The hearing will commence promptly at 6 p.m. and the taking of testimony and comments will end promptly at 8:30 p.m. The final thirty minutes are set aside for Board deliberation on the matter.

At the commencement of the hearing, the Board Chair will determine the number of persons wishing to make a presentation and will allocate the available time among




those persons. Regional Board Staff will be given 30 minutes for their presentation. Goodrich will follow and will have 15 minutes for their presentation. Staff and Goodrich may request time for rebuttal. **Time limits will be strictly enforced.** Only those comments that are directly relevant to the Board's consideration of the draft documents will be accepted. Extraneous and irrelevant information will be excluded. Persons presenting irrelevant or extraneous comments or comments on issues outside the Board's jurisdiction will be directed to stop doing so and may have their remaining time allocation rescinded. **The limit on receipt of relevant comments will be strictly enforced.** The Board will not permit repetitive comments. To the extent that persons wishing to make comments are part of formally or informally organized groups, the Board encourages those groups to select a speaker for the entire group.

In order to provide for an orderly hearing, any documents that will be presented to the Board must be delivered to the Board's offices by November 7, 2005. This will allow the Board, Staff, and Goodrich an opportunity to fully consider them.
