AMENDMENT OF NOTICE OF INCOMPLETE REPORT OF WASTE DISCHARGE DATED OCTOBER 30, 2013

Dear Ms. Skorpanich:

Thank you and your staff for meeting with Regional Board staff on December 11, 2013. As part of that meeting, we discussed the scope of information requested in our Notice of Incomplete Report of Waste Discharge ("Notice") dated October 30, 2013 and your staff outlined the anticipated responses.

As described in the October 30, 2013 Notice, Regional Board staff is open to considering specific recommended changes to the Monitoring and Reporting Program for NPDES Permit No. CAS618030. At the December 11, 2013 meeting, it was generally agreed that the anticipated fifth-term NPDES Permit would continue to allow open opportunities to amend the Monitoring and Reporting Program throughout the term of the Permit. This will allow specific recommended changes to be considered as part of that continual process. As the result, it will not be necessary to receive and evaluate recommended changes to the Monitoring and Reporting Program as part of the Permit's renewal.

Therefore, Regional Board staff is withdrawing our requests for additional information regarding the recommendations listed below for changes to the Monitoring and Reporting Program for NPDES Permit No. CAS618030. The recommendations are identified by the section and recommendation numbers used in your Report of Waste Discharge.

- Section 2.2 (Bacteria), Recommendations 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9.
- Section 2.3 (Nutrients), Recommendations 1, 2, 4, and 5.
- Section 2.4 (Toxicity), Recommendations 7 and 8.
- Section 3.2 (Municipal Infrastructure), Recommendation 4.
