
Dear Mr. Mark Smythe,

Thank you for taking time to talk to me today. Enclosed please find the photos of my facility where we primarily handle all type of papers together with a very small portion of scrap metal being stored inside the metal bins, Amko has been a PAPER processing center in Inland Empire since 2000. Please remove Amko Recycling LLC from this new permit that you are going to derive from the General Industrial Storm Water Permit and the reasons are listed as below.

1. The source of paper is from various commercial accounts, school districts, and the individual household.
2. Amko utilizes Loggman Baler to process all types of papers flowing into our yard.
3. Once they become bundles of paper, they are stored inside the warehouse waiting to be transferred to the paper mill.
4. Same process is applied to the CRV materials including alum can, plastic bottles.
5. Amko has designated two large metal bins for those who would like to dispose their household scrap such as bikes, window frames and patio cover. All scrap is placed into the bin immediately once they are received.
6. SA Recycling in Colton is the place where Amko transfers all ferrous once Amko's metal bin is full:
