TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2006-0064, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR FALLBROOK PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT TREATMENT PLANT NO. 1 RECLAMATION PROJECT, SAN DIEGO COUNTY

By transmittal letter dated May 4, 2006, a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2006-0064, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Fallbrook Public Utility District Treatment Plant No. 1 Reclamation Project, San Diego County*, including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet, was sent to the Fallbrook Public Utility District (FPUD) and other interested parties. The transmittal letter indicated that the tentative Order was scheduled for consideration of adoption by the Regional Board at their regularly scheduled meeting on June 14, 2006.

This letter notifies FPUD and other interested parties that consideration of adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2006-0064 by the Regional Board has been rescheduled to the Regional Board's regularly scheduled meeting on **August 16, 2006** in order to accommodate a request from the California Department of Health Services.

The August 16, 2006 meeting will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will be held at the following location:

The public comment period for the tentative Order is being extended to **August 9, 2006**. A new draft of the tentative Order will not be issued at this time; however, a Response to Comments document, containing the Regional Board's responses to comments received, and an Errata Sheet will be prepared and distributed prior to the Regional Board meeting. The tentative Order and related documents are currently


To date, only comments from FPUD have been received. Per a request from FPUD, the tentative Order will be revised through the Errata Sheet to remove proposed requirements for groundwater and surface water monitoring currently included in the tentative Order. If adopted, the tentative Order would update waste discharge requirements for FPUD for the production and purveyance of up to 2.7 million gallons per day of recycled water.

It is recommended that new or additional written comments regarding the tentative Order be submitted as soon as possible to enable Regional Board staff to amend the tentative Order, if necessary, and allow changes to the tentative Order to be fully reviewed by the Regional Board and interested parties. To ensure that the Regional Board has the opportunity to fully study and consider written material, comments should be received in the Regional Board's office by 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday, August 2, 2006. The final deadline for submittal of written comments, however, is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 9, 2006. Per Regional Board direction, written material submitted to the Regional Board office after the submittal deadline date will not be provided to the Regional Board. Also, it is not likely that written material will be accepted by the Regional Board on the day of the meeting.
