NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD SAN DIEGO REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Water Board) will consider the following actions:

1. NPDES Permit Reissuance: General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharge of Groundwater Extraction Waste to Surface Waters Within The San Diego Region Except For San Diego Bay. (NPDES No. CAG918002, Tentative Order No. R9-2007-0071).
2. NPDES Permit Revision: SeaWorld San Diego. The Regional Board will consider amending SeaWorld's existing NPDES permit to establish waste discharge requirements for discharges of waste from SeaWorld's aerial fireworks displays to Mission Bay, San Diego. (Tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. 2006-0091, NPDES No. CA0107336).
3. Imposition of civil liability recommended in Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint No. R9-2007-0093, against the North County Transit District in the amount of \$160,000 for alleged construction storm water violations of State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) General Order No. 99-08-DWG, from the Spratler Rail Project.
4. Imposition of civil liability recommended in ACL Complaint No. R9-2007-0099, against the Cities of Vista and Carlsbad in the amount of \$1,086,000 for a 7.3 million-gallon sanitary sewer overflow discharge to Buena Vista Lagoon between March 31 and April 3, 2007, in violation of SWRCB Order No. 2006-0003-DWG: Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems.
5. Imposition of civil liability recommended in ACL Complaint No. R9-2007-0101, against the Fallbrook Utilities District in the amount of \$29,300 for a 146,625-gallon sanitary sewer overflow discharge to Fallbrook Creek from a manhole located at 528 Aviation Road between June 17 and 20, 2006, in violation of Regional Water Board Order No. 99-04, General Waste Discharge Requirements Prohibiting Sanitary Sewer Overflows by Sewage Collection Agencies.
6. Imposition of civil liability recommended in ACL Complaint No. R9-2007-0096, against Eastern Municipal Water District in the amount of \$63,500 for a 1.07 million-gallon sanitary sewer overflow discharge to Murrieta Creek from a ruptured 10-inch sewer force main located in the City of Temecula at 28075 Diaz Road on November 14, 2006, in violation of SWRCB Order No. 2006-0003-DWG, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems, and Regional Water Board Order No. 99-04, General Waste Discharge Requirements Prohibiting Sanitary Sewer Overflows by Sewage Collection Agencies.
7. Imposition of civil liability recommended in ACL Complaint No. R9-2007-0064, against Ashby USA, LLC, Rompaugh Ranch Residential Development in the amount of \$546,250 for disturbing Long Valley Wash in unauthorized areas, failing to submit a timely mitigation plan, failing to implement mitigation for impacts to Santa Gertrudis Creek and Long Valley Wash, and failing to adequately design a detention basin implementing post-construction best management in violation of Water Quality Certification No. 01C-091 which was issued in response to impacts to waters of the United States resulting from an 836-acre residential construction site in Temecula, Riverside County.

The Regional Water Board wishes to obtain public input on these matters. For Item Nos. 3 through 7 above, if the discharger elects to waive their right to a hearing, the Regional Board will consider comments received during the public review period and decide on an order accepting payment of the proposed liability and waiver of hearing. The Regional Water Board will hear oral testimony and consider written comments associated with all of the above listed proposed actions at its meeting on December 12, 2007 beginning at 9:00 a.m. in the Regional Water Board Meeting room located at the address listed below.

Interested persons are invited to attend to present testimony. Oral statements will be heard, but for the accuracy of the record, important testimony should be in writing.

2. NPDES Permit Revision: SeaWorld San Diego.
