NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD SAN DIEGO REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Water Board) will consider the following actions:

1. NPDES Permit Reissuance: General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharge of Groundwater Extraction Waste to Surface Waters Within The San Diego Region Except For San Diego Bay. (NPDES No. CAG919002, Tentative Order No. R9-2007-0071),

2. NPDES Permit Reissuance: Waste Discharge Requirements for the Hubbs-Seaworld Research Institute Leon Raymond Hubbard, Jr. Marine Fish Hatchery Discharge to Agua Hedionda Lagoon (NPDES No. CA0109355, Tentative Order No. R9-2007-0026),

3. ACL Order: Imposition of civil liability recommended in Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint No. R9-2007-0093, against the North County Transit District in the amount of \$160,000 for alleged construction storm water violations of State Water Resources Control Board General Order No. 99-08-DWQ, from the Sprinter Rail Project, and

4. ACL Order: Imposition of civil liability recommended in Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint No. R9-2007-0061, against the San Diego Unified School District in the amount of \$128,000 for alleged construction storm water violations of State Water Resources Control Board General Order No. 99-08-DWQ, from the Scripps Ranch Middle School. The Regional Water Board wishes to obtain public input on these matters. Pursuant to Title 23, California Code of Regulations, Section 648.2, the Regional Water Board may refuse to admit written testimony into evidence if it is not submitted to the Regional Water Board in a timely manner, unless the proponent can demonstrate why he or she was unable to submit the material on time or that



compliance with the deadline would create an unreasonable hardship.
