SUBJECT: Waste Discharge Requirements Revision:  
Oak Knoll Campground, San Diego County, Ownership Change.  
(Tentative Addendum No. 2 to Order No. 94-039)

PURPOSE: To transfer responsibility for compliance with Order No. 94-039  
from Mr. Larry A. Read to Oak Village Inc.

PUBLIC NOTICE: Notification of this action was posted on the Regional Board  
webpage on November 10, 2009. This action satisfies the public  
notification requirements of California Water Code, Division 7,  
section 13167.5 for a 30 day notice.

DISCUSSION: Order No. 94-039 prescribes waste discharge requirements for  
the discharge of domestic wastewater at Oak Knoll  
Campground via septic tanks and a subsurface leach field  
system.

The Regional Board was notified on October 14, 2009, that  
ownership of Oak Knoll Campground was transferred from  
Mr. Larry A. Read to Oak Village Inc. on August 25, 2008. The  
tentative addendum if adopted would identify Oak Village Inc.,  
as the Discharger responsible for compliance with the  
requirements of Order No. 94-039.
