ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

- \$10,000 Yearly Revenue Threshold Criteria for Enrollment
 - Coastkeeper v State Board
 - Notice of Non Applicability
- Eliminate “Adjacent to Waterbody” Criteria
- Extend Initial Enrollment Deadline to One Year After Adoption
