


Background:

- Supplemental Environmental Projects (SEPs)
- Enhanced Compliance Actions (ECAs)
- Not otherwise required
- Conform to the Enforcement Policy and SEP Policy
- Must be proposed by the discharger
- Up to 50% as suspended liability



The Penalty Process




Objective & Purpose

- What?
 - Create a list of pre-vetted, potentially eligible projects for dischargers to choose from
- Why?
 - Better align our funding with our regional and state priorities
 - Reduce settlement negotiation time
 - Minimize chance of advisory rejection
 - Address AB1071 & implement R9-2015-0020




Allocations of Fines 2008-2016




Desirable Projects (Project Attributes on Checklist)


