Subject: Notice of Violation No. R9-2016-0070, CalAtlantic Homes, Black Mountain Ranch Disposal Site, San Diego County

Mr. Bruskotter:

Enclosed is Notice of Violation (NOV) No. R9-2016-0070 issued to CalAtlantic Homes, hereinafter the Dischargers, for violations of Water Code sections 13260 and 13264, and Waste Discharge Prohibitions in the *Water Quality Control Plan for the San Diego Basin* (Basin Plan).¹ As described in the NOV, the violations are subject to further enforcement pursuant to the Water Code. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) reserves the right to take any further enforcement action authorized by law.

To avoid further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board on these violations, the Dischargers must take immediate actions to provide the San Diego Water Board with a work plan and schedule for removal of the waste discharge at the CalAtlantic Homes property. Under the authority of Water Code section 13267, the Discharger must provide the San Diego Water Board with a technical work plan and schedule detailing the activities and timeframes for the removal of all wastes from the Property, and the legal disposal of waste excavated from the Property. The work plan must be received by the San Diego Water Board no later than 5:00 pm on March 30, 2016.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION No. R9-2016-0070

Violations of Water Code, Sections 13260 and 13264, and Provisions of the Water Quality Control Plan for the San Diego Basin

March 1, 2016

CalAtlantic Homes, hereinafter the Discharger, is hereby notified that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) reserves the right to take any enforcement action authorized by law for the violations described herein.

The Discharger is in violation of Water Code sections 13260 and 13264, and a Waste Discharge Prohibition specified in the *Water Quality Control Plan for the San Diego Basin* (Basin Plan). The violations described and documented below were identified by San Diego Water Board staff on February 11, 2016 during a joint inspection and investigation with the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency for the City of San Diego (City). The inspection was performed at the CalAtlantic Home site (hereinafter the Property), on which the Discharger maintains an area for the collection and disposal of waste materials incurred as part of the manufacturing of residential homes located adjacent to Lusardi Creek (see Figure 1 below).

A. Summary of Violations

1. Failure to Submit a Report of Waste Discharge

Section 13260(a) of the Water Code requires that any persons discharging waste or proposing to discharge waste within the San Diego region, that could affect the quality of the waters of the State, must submit a report of waste discharge (ROWD) and an annual fee.³ A complete ROWD (Form 200)⁴ must contain sufficient information for the San Diego Water Board to prescribed waste discharge requirements (WDRs).

After discussions with Mr. Kurt Bruskotter,⁵ during the inspection, staff was able to confirm that an ROWD for the discharge of solid wastes on the Property had not been filed with the San Diego Water Board.

2. Initiating a New Discharge of Waste to Land

Section 13264(a) of the Water Code requires that no person shall initiate any new discharge of waste prior to submitting a ROWD,⁶ and satisfying the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

During the February 11 inspection, San Diego Water Board staff observed the that the Discharger initiated a discharge of wastes, including stockpiling and burial of wastes discharged to land as shown in photographs 1 through 6.

3. Failure to Comply with the Basin Plan, Waste Discharge Prohibition

Waste discharge prohibition No. 1 of the Basin Plan⁷ requires that discharges of waste to waters of the State in a manner causing, or threatening to cause a condition of pollution, contamination or nuisance, as defined in Water Code section 13050, is prohibited. Waters of the State include both surface water and groundwater. According to the Basin Plan map,⁸ the Property is located in the San Dieguito hydrologic unit, and the Solana Beach hydrologic area.⁹

During the February 11 inspection Mr. Bruskotter confirmed that wastes being discharged at the Property mostly include concrete, roof tiles, scrap lumber, and drywall. San Diego Water Board staff also observed polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipe fragments, ¹⁰ fiberglass insulation, and steel rebar and nails. During the inspection, City staff expressed concerns that other wastes, which may pose a threat to the environment, may be disposed of at the Property.

To avoid further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board on these violations, the Discharger must take immediate actions to provide the San Diego Water Board with a work plan and schedule for removal of the wastes discharged at the Property. In accordance with Water Code section 13267, the Discharger must provide the San Diego Water Board with a technical work plan detailing the activities and a schedule for the removal of all wastes from the Property, and the legal disposal of waste excavated from the Property. The work

plan must be received by the San Diego Water Board no later than <u>5:00 pm on March 30, 2016</u>.

B. Summary of Potential Enforcement Options

The violations cited above may subject the Dischargers to additional enforcement by the San Diego Water Board or State Water Board, including a potential civil liability assessment of \$5,000 per day of violation (Water Code section 13268) and/or any of the following enforcement actions:

Technical or Investigative Order	Sections 13267 or 13383
Cleanup and Abatement Order	Section 13304
Cease and Desist Order	Sections 13301-13303
Time Schedule Order	Sections 13300, 13308

In addition, the San Diego Water Board may consider referring the matter to other resource agencies, referring the matter to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief, and referral to the municipal or District Attorney for criminal prosecution.
