The submission of written comments is the opportunity for the Discharger and interested persons to raise and comment on issues pertaining to the terms and conditions of the Tentative

Order. Persons wishing to submit testimony, if any, evidence, if any, or comments on the Tentative Order must submit them in writing to the San Diego Water Board so that they are received no later than **12:00 noon on Tuesday, May 27, 2014**.

### **Public Hearing for Consideration of Tentative Order Adoption**

A public hearing on the Tentative Order will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting scheduled for June 26, 2014 in the Board Room, San Diego Water Board, 2375 Northside Drive, Suite 100, San Diego, CA 92108. The item will be heard during a meeting that starts at 9:00 a.m. The meeting agenda, which will indicate any changes in the meeting location and may provide other specific information concerning this hearing, will be posted at least two weeks prior to the meeting date at [http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/board\\_info/agendas/](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/board_info/agendas/)

The Discharger and interested persons may speak at the San Diego Water Board meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written comments. No new issues, not raised in timely submitted written testimony, evidence, or comments, will be permitted. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.

The procedures governing San Diego Water Board meetings may be found at Title 23, California Code of Regulations, section 647, et seq. and are available upon request. The hearing facilities will be accessible to persons with disabilities. The meeting notice and agenda for this meeting will provide contact information for persons requesting special accommodations.
