**SUBJECT: SHIPYARD SEDIMENT SITE 2005 TENTATIVE CLEANUP AND
ABATEMENT ORDER No. R9-2005-0126**

This is a status report on the preparation of the tentative Shipyard Sediment Site cleanup and abatement order (CAO), the supporting technical report, and the indexed electronic record of documents and other information from the San Diego Water Board's file records pertaining to the draft CAO and the supporting technical report. As a follow-up to requests made at the public forum portion of the August 8, 2007 San Diego Water Board meeting, Board member David King, Presiding Officer, Shipyard Sediment Site Proceedings, directed the Cleanup Team to make the following available to all designated parties and the public:

1. Current versions of the tentative cleanup and abatement order and Supporting Technical Report.
2. The supporting documents scanned to date by the San Diego Water Board's contractor.

On August 24, 2007 current versions of the tentative cleanup and abatement order, the draft technical report, and an index of the supporting documents scanned to date were posted on the San Diego Water Board website at <http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/programs/shipyards/Shipyard%20Sediment%20Cleanup/r9-2005-0126%20CUT.html>.

California Environmental Protection Agency

Since August 2007, San Diego Water Board staff has continued to prepare and submit documents and other materials comprising the CAO record on a regular basis to the contractor, D-M Information Systems, for scanning and indexing. Attachment 1 provides summary information on the scanning and indexing progress to date. The San Diego Water Board's contractor has scanned and indexed approximately 238 paper file volumes which translate to 95,967 pages of material. This represents most or all of the material that may ultimately have to be scanned for NASSCO, BAE/Southwest Marine, Inc., and the City of San Diego. During October 1997 staff efforts are being directed towards preparing and submitting material to the contractor pertaining to San Diego Gas and Electric Company, the U.S. Navy, Chevron, Arco, and Marco / Campbell Industries to complete the administrative record for the Shipyard Sediment Cleanup proceedings.

The scanning and indexing of the remaining supporting documents is projected to be completed this fall on or about November 1, 2007. In order to allow for contingencies such as unforeseen problems with the contractors final index product and uncertainties with the size of the record that remains to be scanned, the firm date for expected final distribution of the documents to designated parties and the completion of Phase II of the proceedings is projected to be no later than December 17, 2007.
