Please be advised that the Please be advised that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) intends to rely on the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Tertiary Treatment Plant and Associated Facilities dated April 2004, and Supplemental Environment Assessed April 2004, and Supplemental Environmental Assessment, P-110 Wastewater Conveyance System dated February 2007, when it considers adoption of a Master Reclamation Permit for the Southern Region Tertiary Treatment Plant (SRTTP). The Regional Board received a report of waste discharge (ROWD) for the Southern Region Tertiary Treatment port of waste discharge (ROWD) for the Southern Region Tertiary Treatment Plant (SRTTP) located at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton. The Regional Board intends to consider adoption of a Master Reclamation Permit as contained in Tentative Order R9-2008-0089. As the lead agency under CEQA, the Regional Board finds that the EIS and supplement, prepared by the Department of the Navy, satisfies the CEQA requirements for an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) pursuant to requirements found in California Code of Regulations Title 14. Chapter 3, section 15120 through 15132.

Under the National Envi-ronmental Policy Act, the EIS has undersone public EIS has undergone public notice and review. The EIS considers mitigation measures and analyzes growth-inducing impacts associated with the proposed project. This notice is solely for the use of the EIS as the CEQA document, and the notification of documents requirement pursuant California Code of Regulations Title 14. Chapter 3, Section 15225 and 15087.

Project Description
Under the Tentative Order, the SRTTP will recycle as much tertiary treated wastewater as practically feasible. The SRTTP will operate as a replacement for Sewage Treatment Plants (STP) 1, 2, 3, and 13, which will be converted to pump stations to convey raw sewage toward the SRTTP for tertiary treatment. New piping will be installed to convey the recycled water for discharge as irrigation within the boundaries of Camp Pendleton. Irrigation with tertiary treated wastewater will be limited to uses at a golf course, horse pasture, parade grounds and landscaping. The 300-acreat a golf course, horse pas-ture, parade grounds and landscaping. The 300-acre-feet Lemon Grove Ponds will be used for storage and the Oceanside Ocean Outfall, under a separate National Pollution Dis-tacting Elimination Sys-tem permit (CA0109347), will act as the fail-safe dis-charge point in the event

charge point in the event the reclaimed water volurne exceeds the reuse ca-pacity.

FEIS Preparation and Circulation
A Notice of Intent was published in the Federal Register on April 25, 2001 regarding the development of the EIS. A public scoping meeting was advertised in the Union-Tribune and North County Times, and held on June 19, 2001 to discuss the EIS. The Department of the Nary circulated the complet-19, 2001 to discuss the EIS. The Department of the Navy circulated the completed EIS to public agencies and interested parties in April 2004. The Regional Board received a report of waste discharge for the SRTTP on February 15, 2008. The Regional Board received the EIS and supplement as supporting documents for the ROWD on April 2, 2008. The ROWD and accompanying engineering report contain the final project specifications from the Marine Corps Base. The final project was reduced from the proposed alternative, and therefore remains within the scope presented in the EIS.
