If adopted, Tentative Order No. R9-2008-0096, NPDES Permit No. CA0109347, would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of treated wastewater effluent from the Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton Southern Region Tertiary Treatment Plant Discharge to the Pacific Ocean via the Oceanside Ocean Outfall. If adopted, Order No. R9-2008-0096 would supersede Order No. R9-2003-0155, except for enforcement purposes.
